

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING CLAIM
(See Claim Form on Reverse Side)**

For the purposes of this article, parties of interest and their order of priority are:

- (a) First lien holders of record prior to the recordation of the tax deed to the purchaser in the order of priority; and**
- (b) Then, any person with title of record to all or any portion of the property prior to the recordation of the tax deed to purchaser.**

If you consider yourself to be a party of interest in the sale of tax defaulted property as defined above, please fill out the claim form on the reverse side, stating how you have determined your status as a party of interest.

You must attach copies of documents to support your claim as follows:

1. In case (a), attach a copy of your trust deed or other evidence of lien or security interest, along with a statement under penalty of perjury setting forth the original amount of the lien or interest, the total amount of payments received reducing the original amount of lien or interest, and the amount still due and payable as of the date of the sale of the tax defaulted property by the Tax Collector.
2. In case (b), attach copies of any other documents (e.g., deed, death certificate, will, court order, etc.) supporting your claim.

PLEASE NOTE: Claims will be processed after one year has passed from the date of the deed to the purchaser. In order to receive consideration by the County Board of Supervisors, claims must be received BEFORE THE EXPIRATION OF ONE YEAR following the date of the recording of the deed to the purchaser. Please see the "Date Deed to Purchaser Recorded" appearing on the attached notice (Form TDL 8-20). Following the Board's review, the claim will either be approved or denied. The clerk of the Board of Supervisors will notify you of the action taken by the Board. Should the claim be approved, the Auditor-Controller will, after 90 days, issue a county warrant in payment.
